At Ohio State, your academic options are wide and varied, from pre-professional programs to individualized majors.

With hundreds of majors, as well as specializations and minors, Ohio State is ready to match your brainpower to the best course of study you can find. Not sure what to major in? You're in the right place: with so many options, you're sure to find your fit. To learn more visit exploration.osu.edu.

Undecided? There are many options for undecided students and starting as an undecided major can help you learn more about your options, and more about yourself.

Option 1: University Exploration

Looking to sample courses before committing to a major or just have too many interests to narrow it down right now, you can start in University Exploration. Here you'll have personalized assistance from academic counselors to match your strengths and interests to a major that will lead to a satisfying and rewarding degree.

On the admission application, select either general **University Exploration – Undecided/ Exploring** or one of these six “meta-majors” (broad fields of study):

- Arts, Innovation and Creativity Exploration
- Behavior, Culture and Context Exploration
- Education and Public Service Exploration
- Health and Human Services Exploration
- Management and Industry Exploration
- Science, Technology and Environment Exploration



Option 2: Undecided majors within a college or school

If you have a general idea of the field you want to pursue, but haven't decided on a specific major, consider beginning in an undecided program offered by five of Ohio State's colleges and schools.

On the admission application, select one of the following:

- Agriculture, Exploring
- Arts and Sciences, Undecided
- Business Administration, Undecided
- Environment and Natural Resources, Undecided
- Health and Rehabilitation Sciences, Undecided
- Music, Undecided



APPLYING: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Columbus Campus Application Information

Freshman students to Columbus must apply by February 1

Freshman must submit an application by November 1 if you wish to be considered for an engineering major and for most merit scholarships.

Transfer applicants

Apply by May 1 to the Columbus campus or by June 1 to a regional campus. Visit transferology.com to learn how courses may transfer to Ohio State.

Students considering Columbus and Mansfield are encouraged to apply to Columbus through the common application and list Mansfield as their 2nd choice. Students who have applied to Columbus but want to switch their application to Mansfield need to contact Mansfield about next steps. Students never need to complete a second application. apply.osu.edu

To apply to the Mansfield campus, submit the online application, a nonrefundable application fee and your high school transcripts. If transferring, also include your college transcripts.

Mansfield campus deadlines

You can apply beginning August 1, and the deadline is June 1—the earlier the better!

Tuition and fees

Ohio State is one of the best values among top-ranked public universities. Below are estimated costs for 2022–2023 (two semesters of full-time enrollment).

Billed expenses	Columbus campus	Mansfield campus
Tuition and fees	\$12,462	\$8,956
Room and board	\$14,006	\$9,438

Ohio residents: The Ohio State Tuition Guarantee sets rates for tuition, mandatory fees and housing and dining for each entering class of first-year students. The cost of in-state tuition, general fees, and room and board is held steady for Ohio residents for four years. Out-of-state students can view nonresident rates at undergrad.osu.edu/costs.

Room and board estimates are based on the most popular plans. Students should anticipate additional expenses such as books, supplies, travel, recreation and personal items. These expenses are considered when determining financial aid awards.

Students enrolled at least half time are automatically enrolled in the Student Health Benefits Plan. Visit Student Health Insurance shi.osu.edu.

The Ohio State University at Mansfield annually awards scholarships to new and returning students. Apply online at mansfield.osu.edu/scholarships. Awards are made on a competitive basis, based on financial need and/or other academic or co-curricular qualifications. These are scholarships awarded through either the Mansfield or Columbus campuses rather than external entities. We encourage students also to look for scholarships through local organizations and businesses.

Additional Financial Aid Programs

Buckeye Opportunity Program

Students must complete the FAFSA plus have an admission application submitted by February 1 to be eligible. Students who are Pell Grant-eligible and successfully complete requirements will have the balance of their tuition and fees covered after all other aid is disbursed.

Complete your FAFSA beginning October 1

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) should be completed annually by February 1 to aid Ohio State Mansfield with need-based scholarship decision-making. Go to fafsa.ed.gov for the online application. Students can continue to complete the FAFSA after February 1 for continued scholarship consideration.



Remember to submit an application by February 1 to be considered for the Buckeye Opportunity Program.
