## Math Lesson

## Lesson Title: Slide \& Add

Grade: 1st Grade
Content Standard: NBT.C. 4 - Add within 100, including adding a two-digit number and a one digit number and adding a two digit number and a Multiple of 10, using concrete models or drawings and strategies based on place value.
Materials: 100 charts, dice, counters, 5 Step Lesson Paper, rods, cubes.

## Shared Experience and procedure details:

In pairs, students get a 100 chart, a die, a counter. The 1st partner slides the counter from the bottom of the 100 chart. Read the number the counter landed on. Then roll the die and add that amount to the number the counter landed on. Students then use the rods and cubes to represent the equation.

Play continues with the next partner and then the partners continue to play until time is called.

Possible Picture: 100 chart with the counter on it, rods and cubes to represent an equation

Feature Talk: numbers, game board, dice, rods, cubes, tens, ones, 1 -digit; 2-digit; forward; counting; adding on;

Possible Symbolic Representation: Students can each take one more turn to play and then represent with numbers and math symbols what they just did. They might write an equation with a 2 -digit and 1digit addend with the total. They might draw pictures of the rods and cubes to represent the equation.
