WE are serious about making a world-class education affordable.

OHIO STATE IS COMMITTED TO MAKING A COLLEGE DEGREE ATTAINABLE FOR BUCKEYES EVERYWHERE. Whether it's scholarships, grants, work-study or connecting students to federal or state aid, Ohio State has many resources and ways to help eligible students, and their families, pay for the overall cost of attending college.

- Ohio State Tuition Guarantee sets rates for tuition, mandatory fees and housing and dining for each entering class of first-year students and freezes those rates for four years. Students should anticipate additional expenses such as books, supplies, travel, recreation and personal items. These expenses are considered when determining financial aid awards.
- **Buckeye Opportunity Program** ensures Ohio resident students who submit their FAFSA by Ohio State's priority deadline and qualify for a Federal Pell Grant receive enough aid to cover the full cost of undergraduate tuition and mandatory fees.
- **President's Affordability Grant** provides need-based grants to middle- and lower-income in-state undergraduates.

New first-year applicants:

Complete online application: go.osu.edu/apply2mans

- Pay \$60 application fee
- Submit your ACT/SAT scores (optional)

Note: If you plan to apply to the Columbus campus as your first choice through the Common Application, add Ohio State Mansfield as your second choice. Be sure to only complete one application.

Transfer applicants:

- If you are an Ohio resident and earned a 2.0 GPA on your college coursework, complete the online application: **go.osu.edu/apply2mans**
- Submit your transcripts
- Pay \$60 application fee
- Learn how your course work may transfer registrar. osu.edu/transfer-credit

FILE THE FAFSA

• File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by Ohio State's priority financial aid deadline to receive priority consideration for needbased scholarships, loans, grants and Federal Work-Study. **2025–26 ESTIMATED COST OF ATTENDANCE** Two semesters of full-time enrollment:

\$9,488 tuition
\$6,696-\$9,284 housing (optional)
\$988-\$4,870 meal plan (optional)
\$1,030 books (average cost)
\$3,592 student insurance (optional)*
