Earn your BSBA degree and specialization in business management at one of Ohio State's regional campuses. Admission is guaranteed when specific requirements are met, and transfer, AP and CCP credits are accepted.



EARN A BSBA FROM FISHER

A bachelor's degree program and specialization available exclusively for students at Ohio State's regional campuses

Complete a bachelor of science degree in business administration (BSBA) with a specialization in business management at The Ohio State University at Lima, Mansfield, Marion or Newark. Admission to Ohio State's regional campuses is open to any graduate of an Ohio high school. Indicate business on your application for admission to the Fisher College of Business pre-major program on a regional campus.

Admission to a regional campus program is not capacity-constrained and is guaranteed when the following requirements are met:

- Minimum Ohio State GPA of 3.0
- Completion of 12 letter-graded hours at Ohio State earned post high school graduation
- Completion of 26 total earned hours (can include AP, CCP, transfer credit and Ohio State credit)
- Credit for Math 1131 or 1151 (or equivalent) with a minimum grade of C
- Credit for English 1110.01 (or equivalent) with a minimum grade of C

Applications are accepted three times per year: January 31, June 1 and September 15.

FAQ

What is the BSBA's Business Management Specialization?

Business management is a deeper dive into five functional areas of business: accounting, finance, marketing, operations and human resources. Students in business management complete a mix of courses unique to the program, as well as courses offered on the Columbus campus.

What types of employment opportunities are available for business graduates?

A review of five years of business graduates shows them working in a variety of industries across the state of Ohio. Small business, logistics, farming, insurance and the medical industry are top areas of employment for graduates.

Can I take classes in Columbus?

In rare circumstances students may take one or two classes in Columbus. The program is designed for regional students and is intended to be completed at Ohio State regional campuses.

Can I change to the Columbus campus and a different degree and/or specialization?

Admissions requirements for degree and/or specializations at the Columbus campus are different and must be met before making a campus change. Please consult your academic advisor for current application eligibility.
